You Don't Break So Easily

"I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand."

As human beings we are, in fact, gifted with an incredible resiliency. Skin, bones, psyches, hearts, when pushed to it, these have a remarkable bounce. They don't break so easily and, when they do, they have an unbelievable capacity to heal. We can take a fall, a hurt, a cut, a rejection. It doesn't kill us, we heal; there is seldom an excuse for paralysis, never one for despair.

The most incredible and challenging of all of Christ's teachings is that we can in fact be happy, that we can celebrate and enjoy life, even though we and the world we live in are far from perfect.

We are never beyond healing. Christ's challenge to celebrate is uncompromising. It challenges us to our own capacities, to our own toughness, to love beyond hurt. It challenges us to risk great hurt.

When Christ rose from the dead he showed us that hope is stronger than death itself, in every step we take.

Nikos Kazantzakis starts his autobiography with these words: "Three kinds of souls, three prayers: 1) I am a bow in your hands, Lord, draw me, lest I rot. 2) Do not overdraw me, Lord, I shall break. 3) Overdraw me, Lord, and who cares if I break!" When we know how resilient God has made us, we risk the third prayer.
