"Lifting up his eyes to heaven, Jesus prayed saying: "Holy Father, I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us."

This prayer is tender, intimate, and deeply human. Jesus is about to meet his death, and in these final moments, he prays not for himself but for his disciples—that they may be one, just as he and the Father are one. He prays that the love with which the Father has loved him may be in them, and that this love may strengthen them.

Imagine this prayer that flows through you and I, and all creation. It is THE prayer of Christ that was expressed itself most poignantly in the wood of the cross.

John reminds us in the first chapter that "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made."

Every thought, action and prayer is Christ, for through him "all things exist," including our greatest hopes and desires that dimly reflect the Kingdom of God.

So, even Christ's prayer and Christ's desire becomes ours. It is at the heart of all our hopes for the future of our families and the world.
