The Body and Blood of Christ

Our deepest, most profound prayer is the Eucharist. When the disciples asked Jesus how to prayer, my sense is that they would watch him in prayer, in intimate union with our Creator God, and perhaps say to themselves: "I want that too! I want that relationship with God that John's gospel reminds us: "The Father and I are one."

We yearn for this deep, divine connection within us both unconsciously and consciously with Christ in prayer and charity. But, when we gather around the consecration of bread and wine, and stand once again on that hill in Golgotha under the shadow of the cross, our prayer then becomes, "Accept us Father together with your Son." (Eucharistic prayer)

We seek to fuse our whole being to Christ, to be one with him as he is with the Father. Paul alludes to that when he states the goal of his faith life:

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. (Galatians 2:20)

The extraordinary expression of that desire of Christ and that of our own souls, is to consume the body and blood of Christ. It is our vital submission to God through Christ and the Spirit. We become the body of Christ then, and His presence and power in the world around us. In that embrace with Christ we embrace to all humanity.
