The Mystery of God in the Presence of Trinity

How do we understand the trinity? We don't! God, by definition, is ineffable, beyond conceptualization, beyond imagination, beyond language. The Christian belief that God is trinity helps underscore how rich the mystery of God is and how our experience of God is always richer than our concepts and language about God.

After the resurrection of Jesus, Christians began to understand God in a fuller way. They believed that there is still only one God, but their experience of God demanded that they believe that this God was somehow "three". Stated simply, when Jesus rose from the dead Christians immediately began to attribute divinity to him, yet without identifying him as God the Father.

Jesus was understood to be God, but somehow different from God the Father. Moreover, inside of their experience, they sensed still a third divine energy which they couldn't fully identify with either Jesus or God the Father, the Holy Spirit.

It took Christianity three hundred years to finally arrive at a way to understand God that somehow honored the richness of the Christian experience of God in some way. There is one God in three persons.

"Whatever is going on in God is a flow, a radical relatedness, a perfect communion between Three — a circle dance of love. And God is not just a dancer; God is the dance itself." All love and all life thus flows from the Trinity.
